The Cannabis dispensary that wants to go in up by Tap 22, is just waiting for the Ordinance to go to vote and if everything is approved they will start plans to break ground on that. The Fire Station is getting ready for the Solar, but some engineering reports have to be done to make sure that the roof can handle them first. Rock River Coin will have its ribbon cutting ceremony on Saturday with an open house. I have a call and email to Illini Hospital to see if we can work with them on the land next to Silvis Heights Park as a possible Dog Park. Tomorrow, we have a TIF 8 meeting to go to. It is a TIF review in general and a possible extension. Alderman Pirmann asked about the billboard company and Jerry said that they did come in and told him they are having trouble finding the right piece of land, but they are still working on a location. The mayor asked about the measurements of the rock snake and Jerry said that Geneseo was 104 feet with over \$1000 for their food bank, Hampton was 86 feet, Silvis was 186 feet with \$600 for our food pantry, Rock Falls was 76 feet, and Colona is missing in action. Colona said theirs was out at Scott Family Park and wrapped around the main building, but I went out there and I couldn't find the snake, and no one has seen this snake. Our snake is down by the library right now. Joshua Dyer asked about Iowa Solar and Jerry said he has called 3 to 4 times and he can not get a response back. Chief VanKlaveren said he appreciates everyone who stopped by last Tuesday for the National Night Out Against Crime. We had about 50 kids come out and give away a couple of bikes, food, and drinks. Our newest cop, Nico Castro his first day of being on his own is today. We are now full staff plus one and we are good to go. I just got word that one of our officers has just been deployed. He is in the National Guard so we will be back down to just full staff so this extra body helps us out a bit. Today Chief Winters and I met with Silvis Public Schools to kind of go over our Threat and Crisis Plan for the schools. Next week we will be doing a joint active shooter drill with area schools. We will be introducing a new system called DOOR; it will allow citizens to email complaints in for non-emergency items.

D) Public Works & Parks:

Joe Rockwell said we had the bid opening for the Interconnect today, and Langman did win that bid. I am working on getting grants for the water mains for Glendale, 10th St, and 3rd St. The guys are out striping the streets. Just to elaborate on CDL training, it costs \$5200 for us to send someone to that training, and lasts 4 to 6 weeks. I am waiting for a call back from Milan on how we can train one of our own guys and it costs \$99 a month. Craig asked if we spend the money to have someone trained do we have any kind of guarantee in place that they will not leave after receiving this training and Joe said no. Craig said we might want to consider this as part of the job so that they must stay for a certain period of time.
