Retail Coach, their contract has expired, and we were spending \$25,000 a year on that. They are going to give us a detailed report on what their accomplishments have been, but I do not have it yet. The Grow Facility is going to be up and operating by February. They have 10 employees hired and once phased 2 & 3 are complete they will have about 80 employees. Punk Rock Pizza has been pushed back a bit; they had some plumbing problems. As for the Railroad Heritage project, I have been working with Bi-state to identify some grants that will work for us. I have been going to the Bi-State regional commissions. We met with a couple of different solar companies, we did get with Simple Ray they are going to revisit everything and get back to us. New businesses, 5 Below is the process of opening in the first quarter of this year. Robertson Digital Billboards presented a deal to put one up by Jewel, they will be coming to a meeting to present to us. They looked in Silvis and didn't like any of the areas we had so they met with the owners of Jewel and the one thing I stipulated in the contract was that the City would get 20% of the airtime so we could put anything we want on there. Hospital road project with Bi-State that is still in the process,

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they are working on that Grant application together. The old Ben Franklin building has been sold
