



## Residential Customer Citywide Curbside Clean-up

The City of Silvis & Republic Services will conduct a citywide curbside bi-annual clean-up

### **2026 Pick-up dates:**

- Spring pick-up is scheduled for the week of **April 6<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026**
- Fall pick-up is scheduled for the week of **September 21<sup>st</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup>, 2026**

To help in the effort, please observe the following guidelines:

- ❖ All items must be set-out by 6:00AM on the MONDAY of your pick-up week – **regardless of your regular trash service pick-up day**
- ❖ Once Republic Services has collected items in your neighborhood, they will NOT be coming back through
- ❖ Please be patient, items set-out for this service will NOT be collected with your regular trash pick-up – it will be picked-up sometime during the week listed
- ❖ All items must be placed at the curb or along the street/alley where your trash is usually collected
- ❖ Large items, such as furniture, will be picked-up if placed at the curb or along the street
- ❖ Carpet must be rolled AND tied in sections no longer than 6-feet.
- ❖ **Small items must be contained (i.e. in bags or boxes). Cardboard boxes should be kept dry prior to pick-up**
- ❖ Choose containers carefully – ALL containers will be taken unless marked “SAVE”
- ❖ Containers must weigh no more than 50 pounds each
- ❖ Papers must be placed in plastic bags or tightly bundled with strong string or cord
- ❖ Shredded paper must be bagged
- ❖ Plastic bags must weigh no more than 20 pounds each

### **❖ Excessively large or heavy items are NOT accepted**

- ❖ ITEMS **NOT** ACCEPTED:
  - TIRES
  - APPLIANCES
  - ELECTRONICS / E-WASTE (i.e. TVs, computers, printers, etc)
  - WATER HEATERS
  - EXPLOSIVES OR FLAMMABLES
  - GAS ENGINES OR GAS CYLINDERS
  - PAINTS, OILS, OR OTHER HAZARDOUS WASTE
  - MEDICAL WASTE
  - CONCRETE
  - SHINGLES
  - CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS (i.e. large sections of drywall, lumber, decking, fencing, etc)

## BILLINGS ~ GARBAGE & RECYCLING ~ YARD WASTE ~ MISCELLANEOUS WASTE

### Billings

- Issued 1<sup>st</sup> of each month & due by 20<sup>th</sup> of each month; 10% late fee applies after the 20<sup>th</sup>
- Consumption is billed 2 months in arrears (i.e. January consumption is billed in March)
- E-billing & automatic withdrawal (ACH) available at <https://silvisil.frontdeskworks.com>
  - A profile is automatically created when your utility account is established. Recommend waiting until your first bill is received, then call (309) 792-9181 or stop in for assistance accessing.

### Garbage Service (Monday or Tuesday) - WEEKLY

- Residents are to place their blue-lidded tote of household garbage out by 6:00AM EACH WEEK.

### Recycling Service (Monday or Tuesday) – BI-WEEKLY

- Residents are to place their gray-lidded recycling tote out by 6:00AM EVERY OTHER WEEK.  
See attached paper for dates and acceptable recyclable items.

### Holidays

- In the event that a major holiday falls on Monday or Tuesday, garbage pick-up will run one day behind.
- **Holidays observed by Republic Services are as follows: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day**

### Yard Waste Service (Subscription service through Republic Services)

- Residents are able to sign-up for subscription yard waste service thru Republic Services by calling (563) 332-0050. Fees must be paid at the time the service is set-up.
  - ❖ Full-season service runs ~ April 1<sup>st</sup> through November 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - ❖ Short-season service runs ~ October 1<sup>st</sup> through November 30<sup>th</sup> (or with first measurable snowfall).
- All yard waste needs to be properly bagged in biodegradable bags.
- Brush and branches of 3 inches in diameter, or less, must be cut to 3 foot lengths and bundled & tied. Each bundle should not weigh more than 50 pounds.

### Burn Days

- Call the **City Burn Line** at **(309) 792-3454** to find out if conditions are permissible.
- Monday through Saturday (**NO BURNING ALLOWED ON SUNDAYS**) from dawn until dusk. Only live vegetative matter can be burned. A person and a source of water must be in attendance of a fire at all times. You may only burn on your property. Burning is not allowed on city streets.

### Appliances & Tires

### Hazardous Waste and Electronic Waste

- The Rock Island County Waste Management Agency has an agreement with the Scott Area Recycling Center (5640 Carey Ave, Davenport) to accept our county resident's household hazardous materials, medical sharps, and e-waste (i.e. TVs, computers, printers, phones, DVD players/VCRs, small household electronics, etc.). Call (563) 381-1300 for directions and drop-off times.
- The City of Silvis and Rock Island County occasionally have drop off days a couple times a year. Call the City Clerk's Office at (309) 792-9181 or check [www.silvisil.org](http://www.silvisil.org) for dates.
