- A new interactive app will launch in late spring. TextMyGov is a smartphone-based information communication tool to assist residents with direct communication with the Public Works Department and the Community Service Officer. Service requests may include reporting down trees, potholes, excessive-high grass, abandoned vehicles, and other service requests that will soon be at your fingertips.
- Silvis will soon launch a web-based store for Silvis merchandise. Silvis residents will be able to pick and choose from a variety of apparel items containing the City of Silvis logo.



All items must be set out by 6AM on Monday, June 6th regardless of your regular trash service pick-up day!

All items must be placed at the curb, along the street/alley Carpet must be rolled AND tied in sections no longer than 6ft Small items must be in containers Cardboard boxes must be kept dry prior to pick-up All containers will be taken unless marked "SAVE" Containers must weigh no more than 50 pounds each Papers must be placed in plastic bags or tightly bundled with strong string or cord Shredded paper must be bagged Plastic bags must weigh no more than 20 pounds each
