## City Wide Bulk Trash Pick-up June 6th, 2022

All items must be set out by 6AM  
on Monday, June 6th  
regardless of your regular  
trash service pick-up day!



All items must be placed at the curb, along the street/alley  
Carpet must be rolled AND tied in sections no longer than 6ft  
Small items must be in containers

Cardboard boxes must be kept dry prior to pick-up  
All containers will be taken unless marked "SAVE"

Containers must weigh no more than 50 pounds each

Papers must be placed in plastic bags or tightly bundled with strong string or cord

Shredded paper must be bagged

Plastic bags must weigh no more than 20 pounds each

### Items NOT accepted:

- Tires
- Appliances
- Electronics
- Water Heaters
- Explosives/Flammables
- Shingles
- Medical Waste
- Hazardous waste
- Construction Materials
- Gas Engines/Gas cylinders
